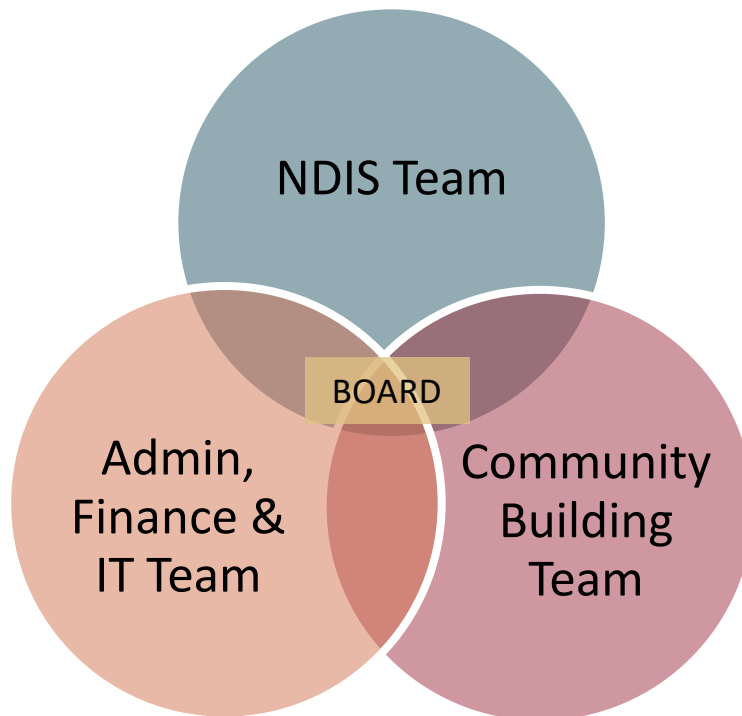


Jeder Institute Membership
